***2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program
Available for Public Review and Comment***

Spokane Regional Transportation Council's (SRTC) draft 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is now available for public review and comment. The TIP is a multi-year funding program document that lists transportation improvements proposed by jurisdictions within Spokane County. It identifies specific programs or projects that jurisdictions or agencies propose to undertake during the upcoming four years. As part of the TIP approval process, SRTC will host a public meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 21 from 4-6 p.m. to gather input on the draft program.
